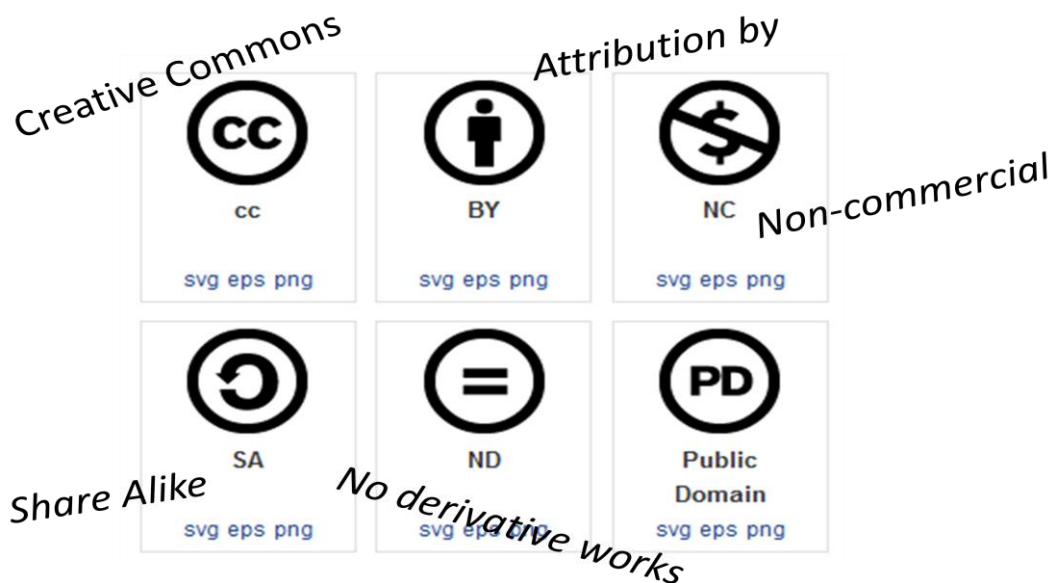
## iT Group August 2010

## Topic: Copyright

At U3A do we need to be concerned about Copyright? Is it OK to download music and use it for weddings, parties etc? Can we copy a movie or documentary from TV and screen it at our local community group, even if at no charge? What pictures can we take from Internet to dress up our documents, flyers, greeting cards, calendars etc? Does anyone care, will anyone notice?

In this session, we will tackle copyright issues relating to citation of books & articles; media – photos, TV, movies, animation clips; audio; and home movies, slide shows and playlists. We will learn about where to access copyright free materials, copyright protected materials with permissions, as set out in Creative Commons. We will also learn how to display and or distribute the finished works in accordance with Copyright law.
